

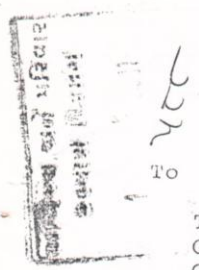

LETTER OF INTENT

Sub.:--Starting of PG degree courses at Govt. Medical College, Rajkot, Gujarat - permission regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your proposal on the subject mentioned above seeking permission of the Central Govt. to start PG degree courses at the College under Section 10(A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 as amended and to say that your proposal was referred to the Medical Council of India for its evaluation and recommendation.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the recommendations of the Medical Council of India in this regard, this Ministry have come to conclusion that a letter of intent for starting of following PG degree courses with annual intake mentioned against each course with prospective effect at Govt. Medical College, Rajkot, Gujarat under Section 10(A) of IMC Act may be issued:-

- 1. MD(Pathology) - 3(Three) seat
- 2. MS(Ophthal.) - 2(Two) seat

Hence this letter of intent.

3. This letter of intent is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipments and hospital facilities as per the Medical Council of India norms.
