Preamble:-


The proposal to start a new medical college in the Saurashtra area of the Gujarat State was under consideration of the Govt. A committee was appointed to select a place to start a new Medical College by Government Resolution shown at Sr.No.2 above. The committee has submitted its report to the Government. After careful consideration of the report the Government has decided to start two Medical Colleges one at Rajkot and another at Bhavnagar with initial intake capacity of 50 seats each.

RESOLUTION:

The Government has decided to start new medical colleges at Rajkot and Bhavnagar with the intake capacity of 50 seats each after obtaining the approval of Govt. of India. The procedure for filing of application to Govt. of India and the subsequent procedural formalities should be initiated immediately.
